YEAR 2024 HOLIDAY ADOPT A FAMILY- “Adopter” Guidelines



The Pawling Resource Center’s “Adopt-A-Family” program operates anonymously and gives individuals, families, and groups an opportunity to “Adopt” a family of any size:

- Small (1 child)
- Medium (2-3 children); or
- Large (4+ children).

This includes buying gifts for children and optionally a food gift card for parents. **Once you return this form to us with your preference, you will be contacted** and given specific requests for an appropriate-sized family. To maintain anonymity, you will be provided with a Family Number (#) rather than the family’s name. When returning the gifts, **very important, please label each gift with the FAMILY #, gender and age of child. i.e. “Family # 3, Male -6 years old.”**

To ensure that all Adopted Families receive an equitable distribution of gifts, please help us by following these guidelines:

- **PLEASE, limit your purchase to a few items of clothing and one fun gift, or to \$70 per child.**
- If you like, you can provide the parent(s) with a food gift card, or a Pawling Chamber of Commerce Merchant’s gift card.
- For those who have difficulty limiting purchases to the above guideline (☺), you may add to our “Gift Box” of special items or toys that will be distributed to needy families who were not “adopted.”
- Donations of Holiday food should be delivered to the Pawling Resource Center and will be distributed equitably among families. (Please do not bring gifts to the Pawling Resource Center).
